INFO ABOUT FRONT-CLIP HARNESSSES

Front-clip harnesses are designed to allow you to clip the leash to a ring at the front of the dog's chest, with a second option to clip on the back of the dog, too. When on the chest clip, many dogs will pull with far less vigor. This doesn't mean they won't pull at all. They'll still need structured training to learn how to walk nicely on a loose leash. But with dogs that pull very strongly, this may be a helpful and humane tool during the training process. The handler will be able to manage the strong puller more easily and safely.

The design of the body harness matters. Some designs can have a negative impact on the dog's shoulders and their natural range of motion.
